

Webbs Break - Rainforest Campground.

Terms and Conditions.

This campground has been designed with minimal rules to be enforced because of the “One booking for the entire campground” Rule. This means there are less rules than most other campgrounds needed to govern the interaction between guests because they are related as Family or Friends.

1: Bookings

All camping guests and their vehicles must be registered to stay at this campground. All Vehicles arriving at Main Entry and Exit Gates are video recorded and must be registered on original booking.

If a non registered vehicle enters the campsite a notice will be sent to the caretakers. Bookings must be made on the website. The person making the booking is the “Responsible Person In Charge”. This means this person is responsible for the safety, decisions and actions for themselves and all other guest campers in their group booking.

There is a two-day minimum booking for weekends and a minimum three day booking for long weekends that include a public holiday. The minimum weekday booking is one night.

All refunds and credits are subject to a minimum administration fee. Once a booking has been made it is locked in. There is a minimum cancellation fee of 10% on all bookings.

Bookings are only allowed to be cancelled when notice is given 21 days or more in advance of the initial check in date. Cancellations made within this 21 day window will not be refunded.

Inclement weather is not a circumstance for any refund. If access to campground is restricted by flood waters a 30-day credit for future use may be given (This means you must make the new booking within 30 days).

Check in time is 1pm on Start of Booking, and the campground is to be vacated by 11am on the day the booking ends.

2: Maximum Number of Guests

The maximum number of guests is 25 including children over 3 years old. Children under 3 years old are free of charge and not included in maximum guest numbers rule.

3: Maximum Number and type of Vehicles Allowed

The maximum number of camper trailers is 8. The maximum number of Vehicles is 12 for camping proposes. (This includes those towing Camper trailers). Caravans or RV's (motorhomes over 4.5 GVM) are not permitted at this Campground as it is unsuitable for them. Campervans over 4.5 GVM are not allowed as it is unsuitable for them. Trucks over 4.5 GVM are not allowed. Vehicles longer than 5.5 meters are not allowed as it is unsuitable. Vehicles towing

Camper trailers should be Four-wheel drive. No tandem trailers allowed on grassed areas. No motorbikes or quads are allowed to be used within the campground apart from access in and out of the campsite areas.

4: Number of sites

Camper trailers can only be set up in the carpark areas. An open grassed area for pitching Tents is available. It is a 25m x 100m area with no separately defined tent sites. Guest may place tents anywhere in this area. The tenting area and the carpark are the only areas in which guests may pitch a tent. Unlimited tents may be pitched in this area. There is plenty of room to spread out.

5: Fires and Firewood

Guests are allowed a campfire in the designated fire pits. An amount of firewood is supplied for each night's stay as part of your campground fee. This is subject to a fire ban restriction being in force. Check www.ruralfire.qld.gov.au (Somerset Regional Council).

6: Pets

Dogs and pets are not allowed.

7: Visitors

Visitors are allowed at this campsite. The fee for a visitor is the same as the adult or child night rate. All camping guests or visitors must be registered to stay or visit at this campsite. All Vehicles arriving at Main Access gate are video recorded and must be registered with Webbs Break. This is for your safety and your security.

This campground and Neurum Creek are privately owned. This means no one is allowed to walk up the creek or through your camp area. It is for your sole use.

8: Internet

The internet is available for guests to use as part of your camping fee. There is sufficient bandwidth for one or two live streams and check emails. (Unlimited)

9: Refuge Area

All garbage must be wrapped in plastic and placed in rubbish bins provided at the refuge area. Please do not allow rubbish to blow around campsite and enter Neurum Creek or surrounding forest.

10: Flora and Fauna

NO DISTURBING NATIVE FAUNA AND FLORA

No hunting or using firearms at this campground and do not collect Native fauna and flora.

Do not collect firewood from the Forest or Gardens. Chainsaws are not allowed at any time.

Please Avoid placing tarps on the ground it will kill the grass. Please use mats or mesh. Tarps are allowed above ground level for shelter on your camp site.

The campsite is located with 100 acres of forrest and adjoins a national forrest. This is a natural habitat that native animals and plants live, breed and survive within. Some of these animals and plants are dangerous, poisonous and venomous. Webbs Break is not responsible for any injuries or deaths caused by campers actions, wildlife, plants or natural surrounds. 11: Campground Boundaries

There are clearly marked Boundaries at this campsite with signs and “sight wire”. They are there to keep your privacy and security. You have 100 acres and the National Park to use.

12: Security Deposit and Damages:

The security deposit will be refunded to the Responsible Person In Charge only if the campsite is left in a reasonable condition when checked out. This includes all rubbish to be deposited in the provided bins, toilet block left in a reasonably clean manner, no damage or theft to the campsite property, bush surroundings or environment.

Any theft or substantial damage will be invoiced to and paid for by the Person In Charge.

13: Waterways and Swimming

The creek is a natural feature of camping and is provided for the enjoyment of the guests. Any flotation devices used and/or provided are for recreational use only, and not to be used as a personal flotation device. It is recommended that all guests know CPR and treat the risks of the creek in a manner that will be safe for children and adults alike. 14: General information about the Campground

There is no mobile phone coverage unless you have Wifi-Calling enabled and connected to WiFi.

There is No 240-volt power. There is good solar lighting in the toilet block and covered area.

There are no bikeways or children’s playground, Rasmussen Road is not suitable for bike riding. There is no disabled toilet or facilities.

There are no tracks for 4x4 driving or motorbikes at this campground. There is only one short driveway.

Any standard car can drive into this carpark and use a tent.

The D'Aguilar National Park is next to this campground and has many amenities and attractions, swimming holes, forest drives and picnic areas.

The campground is within one hour of Brisbane and 20 mins from Woodford or Kilcoy.

There are no BBQ or cooking facilities. You need to bring your own cooking equipment and gas bottles.

You can use your generator or play your music whenever you would like to as there are no noise rules.
